To reward all winter sport enthusiasts longing for skiing and boarding even in spring, Dolomiti Superski has launched the special offer “**Dolomiti Super Sun 2020**” from 11st March to season’s end 2020, according to the opening schedule of the ski areas. Dolomiti Superski gives away one whole ski day. Those who book 7 days accommodation only have to pay for 6 days and for the 6 day ski pass you will only be charged the price of 5 days. KIDS GO FREE

Free day ticket for children <8 years old and discounts for juniors <16 years

This special offer is running for the whole winter season, when the day and multi-day Dolomiti Superski ski pass is free for **children under 8 years** (born after 30/11/2011), when purchasing an adult's ski pass of the same type and duration.

Also the **season ticket** for children under 8 years old **is for free** if bought together with a parents' season ticket. And discounts are also available for older kids on one day or multi-day ski passes (from 1 to 31 days), so **youngsters between 8 and 16** (born after 30/11/2003) have a reduction of 30 %.

The 2019-2020 special treat for families with many children

More reductions for families on day and multi-day ski passes (1-28 days) if purchased at the same time more than 2 ski passes for juniors and parents. Proof of family status is required. More information at the counter.

Valle Silver

It allows skiers to ski for 5 or 6 consecutive days in the four areas of Val di Fassa/Carezza, Val di Fiemme/Obereggen, San Martino di Castrozza/Passo Rolle and Alpe Lusia/San Pellegrino for the 2019-20 ski season. The offer gives skiers over 390 km of slopes and 150 lifts in the skiing areas of Trentino, and parts of South Tyrol and Veneto. Even the ticket price is attractive: the 6-day adult pass costs €226 for the low season, € 255,00 for mid-season and € 283,00 for high season.

“8 days of your choice in the season” skipass

This ticket guarantees even more flexibility for those who do not want to commit themselves too far in advance to too many days on the slope. This pass allows users to plan according to the snow and weather forecast and choose the best days on the Dolomiti Superski slopes. The adult pass costs € 390,00, while juniors (born after 30/11/2003) pay € 260,00.

Points Value Cards

Dolomiti Superski offers the comfortable 600 top up passes (**NEW**) for € 50,00, 1,000 top up passes for € 80,00 and 2,100 top up for € 150,00. Points are taken off when using ski areas when tapping your pass at the turnstiles according to the displayed point chart. Remaining points can be transferred to the next season. The ticket is transferable.

Hotel Skipass Service

Ski pass straight to your room In order to save a trip to the ski pass office after a long travel, Dolomiti Superski offers the “**Hotel Ski Pass Service** ” feature at no extra cost. The customer buys the type of ski pass he wants directly from our website dolomitisuperski.com/hss, paying with his/her credit card. A code will be generated and sent via e-mail to the client and to his booked accommodation. The host will collect the ski pass at the point of sale and the guest will find it in the room at the time of his arrival. The dream vacation can then begin immediately, without wasting time.

DAILY SKI PASS “DIRECTLY TO THE LIFT”

Chip-card that saves 5-10% on the standard daily rate

Also this year, the “Direct to Lift” daily ski pass allows you access to the ski lifts without stopping at the cash desk, saving up to 10% on the standard rates. All this is made possible with the personal “**My Dolomiti Skicard**” chip-card and by signing up to the “**direct to lift**” service, which can be done at any of the ski pass sales points. With the “direct to lift” service, you have direct access to the ski lifts, with the cost of the ski pass being automatically debited to your credit card, having provided your details and authorization at the time of subscription. You will receive a discount of 5% for the first five days of daily use, and from the sixth day onwards you will save 10% on the current rate. The cost of the first day includes an additional 5.00 €, which is for the “direct to lift” service.

10% reduction on a range of ski passes for the more mature skiers

For those who are still young at heart the Dolomites have something special to offer. Dolomiti Superski gives to all people over the age of 65 (born before the 30th November 1954) a **10% discount** on ski passes (except for the seasonal pass). There is no age limit for skiing.
